Although it has not been an easy task, Is there, perhaps, a more intense way to experience Holy Week than in Seville? If the city of Seville always has a special colour, at this time it is even more so. We also know that Seville is a place of good food, so to pay tribute to the city and satisfy every palate, chef Jorge Cortés, from the palace restaurant, Los Rincones del Marqués, offers healthy local Mediterranean cuisine that reflects the essence of Andalusia. There is more, as he also invites us to taste his carefully selected wines that surprise with special flavours and aromas, selected by expert sommeliers.

Everything there exudes essence. From the aroma of orange blossom in the orange tree courtyard, to the warm and friendly atmosphere of the terrace of the 'Patio de las Conchas' (where you can eat), to its splendid wellness area with hammam, contrast showers with chromotherapy, sauna, gym and beauty treatments. A plus: its rooftop terrace, with views of the La Giralda cathedral, is perfect for a calm day.
